INFORMATION

David Austin Roses are magnificent garden shrubs available in many colors. They are wonderfully fragrant, are repeat bloomers over a long season, and are highly versatile.

When planting your roses, we recommend using David Austin Mycorrhizal Fungi. It contains the mycorrhizal fungi and other helpful bacteria to encourage the roots of the plant to establish. This benefits the whole plant throughout its life, promoting stronger growth and more flowers. It also helps the roots of plants to extract water and nutrients from the soil. It is particularly helpful in poorer soils and when transplanting.

When planting as a hedge, space the shorter varieties about 1.5' apart and taller varieties about 3' apart. Adjust the height of the hedge by pruning.

When planting in containers, choose a large one to give the roots more room to develop and prevent the soil from drying out too quickly.

When planting in mixed borders, plant in compact groups of the same variety to create the greatest impact.

When planting in your landscape, position the most fragrant where the scent can be appreciated.

CARE INFORMATION

Site Selection:

Choose a site with 4-6 hours of sunlight daily with good soil drainage and good air circulation.

Soil Preparation:

We recommend a mixture of 50% existing soil and 50% organic matter such as compost, peat moss, or rose planting mix. The addition of bone meal, blood meal or timed release fertilizers will help your plant's roots get established.

How to Prune:

Always prune with sharp clean shears. Cut the roses on an angle above an outward facing bud. Direct the cut to the outside of the plant to encourage denser growth. In spring, trim canes to 6-8', remove dead, damaged and crossing cane first.

Winter Care:

This is important to spring growth. Apply a last round of fertilizer before the first frost. To protect from temperatures below 32 degrees, mound soil 6'' above the crown, or cover with bark mulch or straw.

Fertilize:

Fertilize with a granular fertilizer once the rose is fully leafed out. Fertilize again after the first bloom. Use time released rose fertilizer with systemic, such as Bayer Rose 3-n-1 on a regular basis to assure lush growth.

Water:

Water your rose thoroughly after planting. Water daily for several days, then weekly. Monitor soil moisture throughout growing season.

INFORMATION

These roses consist of **grandifloras**-(Vigorous (comes from floribunda), tall-growing, beautiful, rich blooms (comes from Hybrid Teas), **floribundas**-(clusters of slightly smaller blooms), and **hybrid teas**- (produce showiest blooms, and great fragrance.)

Grandifloras: Longest stem of the tree, up to 7'; spring pruning when necessary; better in bigger spaces due to size.

Floribundas: Can reach up to 6' tall; spring pruning (mainly to remove dead blooms.)

Hybrid Teas: Can reach 4-6' tall; prune while dormant.

All are recommended for avid rose gardeners. For those who want the beauty of the rose without the maintenance, we recommend the Knock Out or Drift Rose varieties.
